Major Production Information

MAJOR PRODUCTION INFO

50% of the posted tuition is required at the time of registration to hold your place in a production. Any discounts should be indicated on the registration form and appropriate documentation included (e.g. awards from previous shows). Discounts will be applied to balance due. Remaining tuition is due on the 4th week of rehearsal. For all major productions, families of cast members are required to sell 15 tickets and payment is due before the final week of rehearsal. Each cast member's family will receive 8 complimentary tickets.

All students must audition for "audition only" productions. Roles may be double cast to accommodate schedules. PCT will attempt to place every actor in a role, but some students may not be cast. If not cast, recommendations will be made for alternate classes or productions.

**An "ACE" Production is a special production targeting more experienced PCT actors. "ACE" members receive advance notice and audition scheduling flexibility, but receive no preferential treatment in casting. Visit www.planochildrenstheatre.org for more information on becoming an "ACE" at MYT!*
